NB:

- Minimum fee indicates the minimum amount payable for a new venture/statutory inspection i.e. the cost for a B&B is £20 per bedroom but the fee for a B&B with 2 bedrooms will be £80.
- Maximum fee indicates the maximum amount payable for a new venture/statutory inspection i.e. the cost for a B&B is £20 per bedroom but the fee for a B&B with 12 bedrooms will be £200.
