


NISRA Accommodation Performance Report

June 2024





NI Hotel Performance Summary

Northern Ireland Statistics and Research Agency (NISRA) accommodation statistics for year-to-date (YTD) January-June 2024 indicate hotel room occupancy and bed occupancy both remained on par with the same YTD period in 2023. Room sales increased by 5% and bed sales increased by 4% compared to YTD 2023. Hotel stock also increased by 5% at end of May 2024, compared to May 2023.

NI YTD '24 Room Occupancy







NI Hotel Room Occupancy by LGD

Room occupancy varied across the Local Government Districts (LGDs) during 2024 YTD (January-June). Belfast LGD and Fermanagh and Omagh LGD recorded the highest room occupancy (73%). Below are the room occupancy figures for 2024 YTD. Figures are not available for some LGDs due to the sample size being too small to provide a reliable estimate.



NI Small Service Performance Summary

NISRA accommodation statistics for year-to-date (YTD) 2024 indicate small service room and bed occupancy (guesthouses, guest accommodation and B&Bs) increased by 4 percentage points and 2 percentage points respectively compared with YTD 2023. Room sales increased by 15% compared to June 2023. Total small service stock increased by 4% at end of May 2024, compared to May 2023.







NI Small Service Room Occupancy by LGD

Room occupancy varied across Local Government Districts (LGDs) during 2024 YTD (January-June). Belfast City LGD recorded the highest room occupancy (68%), followed by Antrim & Newtownabbey (44%). Below are the room occupancy figures for 2024 YTD.



Notes:

- The Northern Ireland Statistics & Research Agency (NISRA) collect hotel and small service accommodation data through their monthly hotel survey and small service survey using a census of Northern Ireland accommodation.
- Small Service accommodation is made up of Guesthouses, Guest Accommodation and B&Bs. Further information on the accommodation categories can be found here.
- Stock used for monthly occupancy is based on the stock at the end of previous month.
- The data has been weighted for non-response, assuming no non-response bias and weighted by local authority and size. Due to different response rates to different parts of the questionnaire, there are different weights for arrivals, guests and weekend/weekday splits.
- Local government district data can only be provided when the sample size is large enough to provide a reliable estimate.
