


# NISRA Accommodation Performance Report

May 2024





#### **NI Hotel Performance Summary**

Northern Ireland Statistics and Research Agency (NISRA) accommodation statistics for year-to-date (YTD) January-May 2024 indicate hotel room occupancy and bed occupancy both increased by 1 percentage point compared to YTD 2023. Room sales increased by 6% and bed sales increased by 5% compared to the same period in 2023. Hotel stock increased by 5% at end of April 2024, compared to April 2023.

NI YTD '24 Room Occupancy




NI YTD '24 Bed Occupancy



#### NI Hotel Room Occupancy by LGD

Room occupancy varied across the Local Government Districts (LGDs) during 2024 YTD (January-May). Fermanagh and Omagh LGD recorded the highest room occupancy (72%), followed closely by Belfast LGD (71%). Below are the room occupancy figures for 2024 YTD. Figures are not available for some LGDs due to the sample size being too small to provide a reliable estimate.





#### NI Small Service Performance Summary

NISRA accommodation statistics for year-to-date (YTD) 2024 indicate small service room and bed occupancy (guesthouses, guest accommodation and B&Bs) increased by 5 percentage points and 2 percentage points respectively compared with YTD 2023. Room sales increased by 18% compared to May 2023. Total small service stock increased by 5% at end of April 2024, compared to April 2023.







### NI Small Service Room Occupancy by LGD

Room occupancy varied across Local Government Districts (LGDs) during 2024 YTD (January-May). Belfast City LGD recorded the highest room occupancy (67%), followed by Antrim & Newtownabbey (42%). Below are the room occupancy figures for 2024 YTD.



## **Notes:**

- The Northern Ireland Statistics & Research Agency (NISRA) collect hotel and small service accommodation data through their monthly hotel survey and small service survey using a census of Northern Ireland accommodation.
- Small Service accommodation is made up of Guesthouses, Guest Accommodation and B&Bs. Further information on the accommodation categories can be found <a href="https://example.com/here">here</a>.
- Stock used for monthly occupancy is based on the stock at the end of previous month.
- The data has been weighted for non-response, assuming no non-response bias and weighted by local authority and size. Due to different response rates to different parts of the questionnaire, there are different weights for arrivals, guests and weekend/weekday splits.
- Local government district data can only be provided when the sample size is large enough to provide a reliable estimate.
